

Can I have the coronavirus test at home?

Yes, the test to determine if you have coronavirus (COVID-19) is available for you to have at home. You need to have a GP request that a staff member from Pathwest comes to your home.

This would usually happen if it is difficult for you or your family member to attend the COVID-19 Clinic for testing. For example, you or your family member may need to be hoisted from bed to a wheelchair and then get into a wheelchair taxi to take you to the clinic.

If you believe you or a family member has coronavirus or has had contact with a person who is positive, contact your GP to come to the house or through a teleconference.

The GP will send a referral to the pathology team. Staff from the pathology clinic will phone you to make an appointment before they come to your house to do the test.
